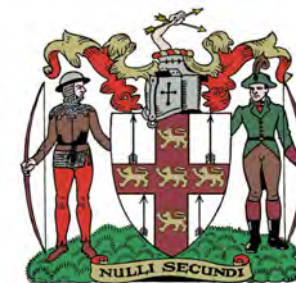

- Foam bosses will be used for the majority of, if not all, targets.
- Archery GB Rules of Shooting (including dress rules) will apply.
- Timed ends of 6 arrows will apply.
- Practice bosses will be available on Friday from 3p.m.
- Dogs are allowed on the Shooting Ground provided they are kept under strict control and on a lead. (Must be exercised off the Shooting Ground and caravan site.)
- Camping & Caravans. Stay Friday & Saturday nights with your tent or caravan. £6.00 per van or tent per night. The ground must be vacated by 7p.m. on Sunday evening. Space is limited so please email the organiser to check availability before booking.
- The use of portable gas appliances or BBQ's will not be permitted on the shooting field in the interest of archers' safety.

**Please Note:-** When you enter our competition the information you give us will be collected and used by the Club in relation to running this and future shoots. Certain information will also be used in a scoring system and will be shared with other competitors on target lists and result sheets and may be published, eg: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Age category, County, Region, Round (unless defined by age), Disability and marital status where relevant to an award or category. Contact details will be kept in relation to the return of trophies and to comply with Archery GB rules regarding Record and Rose Status tournaments and to notify archers of future competitions held by the Club.

## **New Century Bowmen Open York/Hereford/Bristols I-V (The Double Round)**

### **AWARDS**

#### **THE JAY-DEE TROPHY**

for the highest Recurve score on either the Double York or the Double Hereford Round. The winner of this trophy is not eligible as the First Lady, First Gentleman or First Junior.

**AWARDS** in all classes and age groups are dependent on entries.

#### **TWISTED ARROW TROPHY**

A team of 3 Recurve archers from one club all shooting senior rounds (not 50+ rounds), one of which must be a lady or a junior shooting the round of their gender.

#### **BEST GOLDS**

Ladies, Gents & Junior Classes.

#### **YORK**

Men and U21 Men

#### **HEREFORD/BRISTOL I**

Women, U21 women, U18 men & 50+ men.

#### **BRISTOL II**

U18 women, U16 men & 50+ women.

#### **BRISTOL III**

U16 women & U15 men/women

#### **BRISTOL IV**

Under 14 men/women

#### **BRISTOL V**

Under 12 men/women

*We are happy to allow any archer to shoot the round of their choice and would ask you to state on the entry form which round you wish to shoot. Awards however, will be given on the basis of the above rounds and age groups.*

**Awards for the Double Round only.** Awards for all styles and age groups according to entry. (Archers are welcome to shoot single days but no awards will be given.) If the tournament is abandoned awards will be awarded up to and including the last complete end shot.

**RECORD STATUS SHOOTS** will be liable for Drug Testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If competitors refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

**PHOTOGRAPHY.** In order to comply with the AGB Protection of Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival.

**DISCIPLINE.** The Director of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. Their decision in all matters is final and must be obeyed. The Tournament Organiser has the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour.
