Awards:	Medals subject to entry for ladies, open, 50+ & juniors - recurve, compound, barebow & longbow. Other bowstyles may shoot but will not be awarded
Faces:	Recurve and compound archers will shoot on vertical 3 spot 40 cm faces Barebow and longbow archers will shoot on individual full 40 cm faces
Bosses:	All archers will shoot on layered foam bosses
Clothing:	Archery GB dress rules (rule 307) will apply
Note:	Out of respect to your fellow competitors you will not be able to enter the range to set up until the preceding session has finished shooting
Refreshments:	Hot & cold drinks and cakes will be available during the shoot
Drug Testing:	Record status shoots are liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give a sample must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result.
Photography:	In order to comply with the ArcheryGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival.
