Bosses:	Archers will shoot on a mixture of layered foam bosses and traditional three-legged target stands for the shorter rounds. Please consider this if you are using a high-powered bow and arrows that you think may be affected by such bosses and stands.		
Rules	The shoot will be shot to Archery GB rules of shooting - Archery GB dress rules (rule 307) will apply.		
Refreshments:	Hot & cold drinks will be available during the shoot and cake will be provided at the end of the shoot		
Photography:	In order to comply with the ArcheryGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival.
